

## **Boonville Soccer Academy fees and club information for accepted players**

**What to expect from us:** Players will practice twice per week for 60-90 minutes; on days and times determined by the individual coaches. High school players will have an additional practice day. The players will be taught the skills to become successful individuals and team players by coaches who have a love for, and knowledge of, the beautiful game. We are a player development club, and our emphasis is just that; we do not focus on winning games but on gaining skills and creativity within the game. Players will play games each season in our developmental M3 league with a small-sided team. Most teams will also play competitive full-sided games in our MMSL league. Both leagues are in Boonville. Many teams will compete in one or two tournaments as well. Players will be issued a ball, two practice t-shirts, and uniform socks each year. We are a small club, and we pride ourselves on our club's solidarity and our player development philosophy.

**What we expect from you: Players are making a year-long commitment to the club** (fall and spring), with an optional winter season in between. For high school players, this means they play for us in the season opposite their high school season (fall for girls, spring for boys) and are eligible to play futsal in the winter. All other ages are expected to play in both fall and spring. **We expect consistent attendance at all practices and games. This is the most important thing we expect from players!** Before you commit to the club and the team for the year, please be sure that you will be able to get to practice and games consistently. We are a competitive club, and we expect our players and parents to take training seriously. It is unfair to your player, other players, the team, the coach, and the competition if you only show up occasionally or do not participate fully in practice. Players need practice time to learn the skills, and game time to put those skills to use and gel as a team. Athletes that attend sporadically because of a low commitment level, or do not participate in practice, will not be able to keep up with teammates. We expect players to show up with a good attitude and be prepared with all their equipment; players and parents to be respectful toward their coach, teammates, referees, and other parents on both sides of the field; and timely payment of fees. We also encourage further involvement with the club, such as volunteering for tournaments, assistant coach and team manager positions, etc. An active role in the club is crucial to our success!

Boonville Soccer Academy is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. All your fees support our soccer programming. The club fees cover the equipment, coaching fees, field rentals, and other club and day-to-day expenses. The game fees cover the league games and/or tournaments each season. Some teams may go above and beyond the game fees collected, in which case the balance will be divided amongst the players and collected as the final payment. **New players pay a one-time uniform deposit fee of \$50.** Families with multiple players will receive a \$50 sibling discount for each subsequent player. Uniforms are provided by the club and returned at the end of each year.

Payments can be paid according to the payment schedule or can be paid all at once. If you pay by card, future payments will be charged automatically. Failure to pay on time may exclude players from game play until delinquent fees are paid. Games and tournaments will vary by team; any fees above and beyond the initial game fees will be charged as the final payment of the season. Tournament expenses such as hotel, food, and travel are not included and are the family's responsibility. We do recognize families may have special circumstances, if you need to discuss payments please contact us.

**Teams:** Missouri Youth Soccer and US Youth Soccer have set the standard as to how we classify the ages of our players. They have mandated a change back to a school year age matrix. Teams will be formed based on 8/1-7/31 dates. All players of the same gender, in the same age group, will be together. Generally, we combine age groups to form full teams, so they may be grouped with players born either the year before or after them. We will do what we think is best for the player and the team. High school players will be placed on the high school team of their gender. Teams will be finalized after registration has closed.

**Games:** Our teams participate in the Mid-Missouri Micro (M3) League and the Mid-Missouri Soccer League (MMSL). All league games are played in Boonville. Teams will have a combination of games, and it will vary by team. The M3 is a small-sided league where players get lots of ball touches and experience; teams play 3v3 or 5v5 based on age. The MMSL is a full-sided league where players learn the “big game” and gain experience for the future. Teams play 7v7, 9v9, or 11v11 based on age. The minimum number of games will be 6 M3 games (3 weekends) and the maximum will be 8 MMSL games (4 weekends) plus 6 M3 games (3 weekends) plus up to 2

out-of-town tournament weekends. This will vary by team and will be finalized after registration has closed and we have a final roster for each team.

Practices will start in July or August; practice start dates, days, and times will vary by team. Teams play on Saturdays in the MMSL and Sundays in the M3, weekends will vary. League games will run from August – October in the fall and March – May in the spring. Our players get high-quality training, more touches on the ball, play fast-paced competitive games with little travel in the M3 league (3v3 or 5v5) against local and other mid-MO teams. Teams that have enough players for full-sided play compete in the MMSL (7v7, 9v9, or 11v11) against other competitive teams. They may also choose one or two additional tournaments out of town, or locally if one is available. Coaches may also set up friendly games during the season. This will all vary by team. Expect to hear from your coach in late June or early July about practices and league and tournament plans. Some players will have summer opportunities before the official season starts.

### **To register:**

A parent/guardian must complete & sign all registration documents for players under 18. Using a desktop or laptop computer to complete the registration steps below will make for the best experience. New players should have a birth certificate, photo (full face, no hats or sunglasses), and insurance information on hand.

- **CLICK THE LINK TO START: \*\*link provided in email to accepted players\*\***
  - Log in using your GotSport ID and password or new users should select “Create an Account.”
  - Select the player to register or search “Add Family Member” to set up a new player.
- **Profile Tab:**
  - Add/update player photo. This should be a basic head/shoulders snapshot like a school photo.
  - Confirm that all contact information is correct
  - SAVE & CONTINUE
- **Parents Tab:**
  - Confirm information & enter an additional parent/guardian if applicable
  - SAVE & CONTINUE
- **Emergency Information Tab:**
  - Emergency Contact information
  - Medical Information
  - Insurance Information
  - SAVE & CONTINUE
- **Registration Tab:**
  - Select shirt size for your player
  - Read the code of conduct and sign at the bottom to agree
  - SAVE & CONTINUE
- **Waivers/Release Forms:**
  - MYSA Birth Certificate (Note: US Soccer International Clearance required for players born outside of the United States).
  - MYSA 26/27 Competitive Player Fee (\$19 state association fee is paid directly to MYSA) Don’t stop here – keep going!
  - MYSA Release

- USSF Player/Parent Code of Conduct
  - USYS Code of Conduct > CONTINUE
  - Safe Sport information (can bookmark for later)
  - Parent agreement >CONTINUE
- Payment Tab:
  - Select your payment option - you should see only the option that applies to you.
  - CHECKOUT
- Features:
  - New players must select the uniform deposit
  - The sibling discount will be applied automatically for subsequent registrations
  - CHECKOUT
  - Continue checkout to pay and complete registration or add another player. All players in the family must be registered before completing checkout to receive the sibling discount.
- Repeat steps for siblings
- To complete the checkout, enter your credit card number or select pay by check and continue. Monthly installments will be charged automatically to the card on file. If you choose to pay by check, follow the payment instructions in your confirmation email.

Participants should receive two confirmation emails once registration is fully submitted; one when you pay the MYSA fee and a second one when you've completed the registration.

**We communicate via email and GroupMe. Please check your email regularly to receive club and team information and have your Group Me notifications on during the season.** You can also like us on Facebook for regular updates and reminders, but all vital information will come to you via GroupMe and/or email. Team groups will be formed or added to after player registration.

**All players MUST be registered by the stated deadline to be placed on a team.** By registering, you are committing your player to the Boonville Soccer Academy for the full 2026-27 year, and agreeing to attend practices and games consistently and as a team player. Should you choose to transfer to another club, transfer fees will apply.
